The Feast of Tabernacles

This is the feast that all the saints were to look forward to. Not only commanded, but joyfully acceptable between heaven and earth. A vital part of the covenant.

Among other things, it was a feast of victory and conclusion. That would mean that during the last Feast of Tabernacles Satan could no longer harass earth's heavenly family.

Talk about relief! Talk about reason for joy! To say nothing of the fact that they had plenty of harvest from their previous year of labor.

Many years later, Paul the apostle, kept the feast at various locations showing that it is the heart that counts

the most, and besides, the sanctuary had been destroyed by Rome: To his flock at Corinth Paul wrote:

Let us therefore keep the feast, not with malice and wickedness, but instead with sincerity and truth.

From 1st Cor. 5:7

And yes, the true sanctuary is still standing today. John the Revelator saw it there, both apartments and the furniture. Well intact.

"As in vision the apostle John was granted a view of the temple of God in heaven, he beheld there 'seven lamps of fire burning before the throne.' He saw an angel having a golden censor, and there was given unto him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints upon the golden throne which was before the throne." Rev. 4:5; 8:3



Here the prophet was permitted to behold the first apartment of the heavenly sanctuary in heaven; and see there the golden candlestick and the altar of incense in the sanctuary, "seven lamps burning before the throne."

So, the message is clear. Though the sanctuary was in heaven "where robbers can't break in," they continued to pray toward the new Jerusalem wherein are those whom Paul deemed "the church of the firstborn."

What the early church did, and what today's "Christian" and their leaders say they did are two different things. They took the feast seriously wherever they were, and we would do well to follow the true original leaders.

There is a sanctuary and there are folk who know it to be so, and they meet to honor the Feast of Tabernacles and He that is represented there. We thus connect ourselves to heaven, the sanctuary, and its Creator.

Yashua showed in three or four lessons that Sodom was a city in big trouble with His law.

"And whosoever shall not receive you, nor hear you, when ye depart thence shake off the dust under your feet for a testimony against them. Verily I say unto you: It shall be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment, than for that city."

Both Sodom and Gomorrah had been judged years before Christ spoke about it. The destroying angels caused fire to come down on those two cities until there is nearly nothing left. I personally visited the site and was convinced of the evidence. I chiseled a few balls of sculpture from the stones and brought them home.

What is interesting is that their final judgment was to be future of that time. Also, in rich tones, is the call to leave those cities before their judgments begin to fall. THE CHRISTIAN POST CHURCH AND MINISTRIES

Anglican Church of Canada votes to allow gay marriage ceremonies. They leaned on a statement from the chancellor of the general synod, who said the current marriage canon does not specifically ban solemnizing same-sex marriages. The Anglican Church of Canada is not the first member of the Anglican Communion to go against Biblical doctrine and recognize gay marriage last year. The Episcopal Church, based in the United States, approved a similar measure.

FLOOD IN LOUISIANA



Some say as bad as Katrina in New Orleans.



I've seen many pictures of the Baton Rouge area where folk have piled up their wet and mildewing clothing, papers, pictures, bedding, etc., piled up along the street in front of their houses waiting for the waste management trucks to haul it to the dump. The houses behind the piles all water drenched and otherwise ruined.





36 relatives lost 13 homes near Baton Rouge. Over 40,000 homes have been lost and many more severely damaged. Oh where are we on the clock of time that numbers our days here on this dying planet? Dying because the people have chosen the wrong master, masquerading as Christ. Soon he will appear on the

earth as an angel of light to hasten his people to their death and terrorize the true children of Israel.

Here below is a lot of water! Compare these two pictures. One was taken by someone in a boat going by on this street, the bottom one that is joined to it shows the same houses after the water receded with all the soggy contents and memories being tossed in trucks loaded for the dump!



The other side of the country seems to be burning. What a dilemma! Flooding on one side and burning on the other.

Presently there are at least 7 massive fires burning in the west. Home after home is wiped out as 7 fires rage across the western U.S., mostly in California.

IN CALIFORNIA

The Clayton fire in and near Lower Lake has destroyed 189 homes, 8 commercial buildings and 102 "other" structures! It is still burning!





The Blue Cut fire above San Bernardino, California has taken 37,020 acres and along it's ugly march destroyed 105 homes and 216 outbuildings. Some of these outbuildings were well-built horse and/or machinery barns. It still continues to burn.

The Soberanes Fire (near Big Sur, California) has burned 83,830 acres so far, 57 homes and 11 outbuildings, and is getting very close to the famous landmark Hearst Castle. The Rey Fire near Santa Barbara is over 13,000 acres and not nearly contained!

Closer to us here in Terra Bella is the Cedar Fire (near Wofford Heights/Lake Isabella) which has already burned over 20,000 acres and is only 5% contained. We can see the golden embers from here at night along the mountain ridge.

Near to our state of California there is the Beaver Creek Fire near Walden, Colorado having burned 36,961 acres; the Rail fire in Oregon having burned 29,532 acres; and the Pioneer fire near Boise Idaho having burned 87,818 acres. Many in Wyoming and Washington State, too. That's a lot of natural resources vanishing before our eyes and some of them are still burning. Lots of dead wood/trees in all these areas from the beetle bug damage in the last few years is adding fuel to all these fires.

ARE THEY A WARNING?

Is our heavenly Father sending a message with all of this? Is He letting us know what will transpire in the cities if sincere repentance is not forthcoming?

"In the night I was, I thought, in a room but not in my own house. I was in a city, where I knew not, and I heard explosion after explosion. I rose up quickly in bed, and saw from my window large balls of fire. Jetting out were sparks, in the form of arrows, and buildings were being consumed, and in a very few minutes the entire block of buildings was falling and the screeching and mournful groans came distinctly to my ears. I cried out, in my raised position, to learn what was happening: Where am I? And where are our family circle? Then I awoke. But I could not tell where I was for I was in another place than home. I said, Oh Lord, where am I and what shall I do? It was a voice that spoke, 'Be not afraid. Nothing shall

harm you.' I was instructed that destruction hath gone forth upon cities. The word of the Lord will be fulfilled. Isaiah 29:19-24 was repeated. I dared not move, not knowing where I was. I cried unto the Lord, What does it mean? These representations of destruction were repeated. Where am I? 'In scenes I have represented that which will be; but warn My people to cease from putting their trust in men who are not obedient to my warnings and who despise My reproof, for the day of the Lord is right upon the world when evidence shall be made sure. Those who have followed the voices that would turn things upside down will themselves be turned where they cannot see, but will be as blind men.' These words were given me from Isaiah 30: 'Now go, write it before them in a table, and note it in a book, that it may be for the time to come for ever and ever: That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the Lord: Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us smooth things, prophesy deceits.' [Isaiah 30:8-15 quoted.] As instructed that light had been given me and that I had written under special light the Lord had imparted."--Ms. 126, 1906. (Diary, August 23, 27, 1906.)

Welcome to Fall 2016 Feast of Tabernacies



Note: Campgrounds will be available the prior week and stay longer, too (no charge).

If coming from the South, plan on 45 minute drive north from Bakersfield. Take Hwy 99. Passing through Bakersfield on Hwy 99 you will come to a cut-off to the right marked Hwy 65 to Porterville and Sequoia Parks. Take Hwy 65 north (the only way you can) past Ducor to Terra Bella, Ave. 95, (this is a stop signal). Turn East (right) on Ave. 95 & go about 3 miles to Rd. 256. Turn left (North) onto Rd. 256. Continue one long block to Ave. 100. Ave. 100 goes only to the right (East). Look for a red house on the left about one block from the corner of Rd. 256 and Ave. 100. The address is 25810 Avenue 100, Terra Bella, CA 93270.

If coming from the North, plan on 11/2 hour from Fresno. Continue South on Hwy 99 to Pixley. Watch close; it is but a little distance from Tipton. Take Ave 96 East to Hwy 65. Ave 96 will become Ave 95. (Continue east past the town of Terra Bella on Ave. 95 about three miles to Rd. 256. (There is Tuff Products at this' corner). Turn left (North) on to Rd. 256. Continue one long block to Ave. 100. Avenue 100 goes only to the right (East). Look for a red house on the left about one block from the corner of Rd. 256 and Ave. 100. Address is 25810 Avenue 100, Terra Bella, CA 93270. Campground entrance is on east side of house.
